The San Joaquin River Conservancy is an agency of the State of California created by the State Legislature in 1992 to create the San Joaquin River Parkway by: acquiring 5,900 acres for the Parkway from willing sellers; enhancing and restoring riparian, floodplain, and aquatic habitat, and conserving natural and cultural resources on its lands; and developing and managing its lands for public recreational and educational use compatible with resource protection. The Conservancy also assists other entities in conserving and improving their lands for the Parkway. The Conservancy is working to facilitate the development of the Parkway, cultivate public support, and secure its future.

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
