1. CONSERVE CORRIDOR ON AT LEAST ONE SIDE OF RIVER. APPLY THE SAME BUFFERS TO AREAS DESIGNATED AS "NATURAL RESERVES." ALLOWED USES IN THE RIVER WILDLIFE CORRIDOR INCLUDE RIVER DEPENDENT ACTIVITIES INCLUDING FISHING, RIVER ACCESS, BOATING ACCESS, AND HIKING TRAILS.
 2. SAME BUFFER FOR LOW INTENSITY PARKWAY RECREATION, DEFINED AS HIKING, BIKING, HORSEBACK RIDING, AND GOLF.
 3. DEFINED AS LARGE CONCENTRATIONS OF PEOPLE CAMPING OR PICNICKING, PARKING, OR EQUESTRIAN STAGING AREAS.
